

2200 W Sliding Mitre Saw TT-SM 2534 DUAL

QUICK START GUIDE

Easy steps to getting started.

- 1. Read the User Guide for all SAFETY aspects of using your TAURUS TITANIUM® 2200 W SLIDING MITRE SAW.
- 2. Carefully remove the SLIDING MITRE SAW from the packaging, take care that you have all parts supplied in the packaging before discarding.
- 3. Make sure the equipment is set up where it can stand securely, i.e. it should be bolted to a workbench, a universal base frame or similar and all covers and safety devices are fitted properly before the equipment is switched on.
- 4. Assemble the Sliding Mitre Saw as described in Section 7.2 of the User Guide.
- 5. Make sure that no other tools, wood scraps, etc. (except the work piece) are on the table before you start the saw.
- 6. Secure your work piece safely. Use the provided clamp (8) to support the work piece whenever possible, short work pieces must always be clamped. Work pieces longer than the actual work table must be supported by the workpiece supports (10) or saw horses.
- 7. Make the necessary adjustments to the Sliding Mitre Saw according to the cut (Straight cut, Mitre Cut, Bevel Cut or Compound Mitre Cut) you intend to perform. Refer to Section 7 and 8 of the User Guide for detailed information.
- 8. Move the laser ON/OFF switch (36) on the side of the mitre saw handle to the "I" position to switch on the laser (35). A laser line is projected onto the material you wish to process, providing an exact guide for the cut.

 Important! Never look directly into the laser path.
- Before you actuate the ON/OFF switch (2) of the saw, make sure that the saw blade (7) is correctly fitted and that the equipment's moving parts run smoothly. Refer to Section 8.7 of the User Guide for instructions on how to change the saw blade.
- 10. **Important!** When you switch on your saw, let the blade reach its full speed before contacting the work piece.
- 11. For detailed instructions on how to perform the different cuts, please refer to Section 8.1 to 8.5 of the User Guide.
- 12. Make sure you wear safety glasses and no loose clothing or jewellery when you are using the mitre saw.
